So, the question are;
What is the name of <u>the Father</u> ?
What is the name of the Son ?
What is the name of the Holy Ghost ?
We know that the easiest name to know is the <u>son's</u> name .
Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name <u>JESUS</u> : for he shall save his people from their sins.
Luke 2:21 And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child his name was called <u>JESUS</u> , which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.
His name is <u>Jesus</u> (Yeshua – "")
Hebrews 1:2-4 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, (Matthew 28:18 "411 power is given unto in heaven and in earth")
(Matthew 28:18 "All power is given unto in heaven and in earth.")
by whom also <u>he made the worlds</u> ;
(John 1:10-11 "He was in the world, and the world was made by,)

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express <u>image</u> of his person,
(John 14:9 Jesus "he that hath seen hath seen the Father")
and upholding all things by the word of his power,
(Matt. 24:35 "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but words shall not pass away.")
when he had by <u>himself</u> purged our sins,
(John 1:29 "Behold the of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.)
sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;
(Rev 7:17 the Lamb which is in the of the throne shall feed them)
4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a <u>more excellent name</u> than they.

John 5:43 I am come in **my Father's name**, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.
